

Student Leadership Application

What Is It?

Student Leadership is an opportunity for students in Jr. or Sr. High to help make the ministry of the youth group at Resurrection actually happen. Students who participate will be on a team assigned to a specific task necessary to help the youth group function properly. Without these teams, we will not be able to have a full-fledged youth ministry; your participation is vital!

Students who participate will take extra responsibility and ownership over segments of the youth program, test out and find their gifts and passions, and experience fellowship and fun with other committed students, all the while growing deeper in their walk with Jesus.

How Can I Be Involved?

Worship Team: This team will be responsible to lead our group in worship through music, prayer, Scripture reading, and artistic expression. Worship times will occur primarily during Sunday night Youth Group, and will happen about once a month; plus retreats and other special occasions. Some members will need at least basic musical ability, but not everyone.

Fun Events / Games: The task of this team will be to plan and lead our game time from week to week during Youth Group. This team will also plan, get the word out, and lead our Fun and Outreach nights that will occur about once a month.

Hospitality: This team will be responsible to foster Christian fellowship through bringing food, giving warm attention to newcomers, and brainstorming creative ways to invite others in.

Work It (Mission Events): These students will plan, organize, and execute our periodic mission events that we call “Work It.” This is for students who are good at organizing, or who love to serve others in practical ways, bringing the love of Jesus to the world around us.

What do I need to do? Commitments:

- 1) Fill out this application and return to Brett either through email or a hard copy in person
- 2) Commit to be at Sunday night Youth Group each week (max of 4 absences per semester)
- 3) Commit to attend leaders’ meetings, held at Brett and Julie’s home. Fall semester dates:
 - a. Friday, Sept. 21, 5:30 – 9:00pm
 - b. Saturday, Oct. 27, 10am – 1pm
 - c. Friday, Nov. 30, 5:30 – 9:00pm
 - d. Your individual team might plan extra meetings outside of these
- 4) Commit to pray for the Youth Group
- 5) Be involved in another ministry at school or at church (FCA, Christian clubs at school, church choir, children’s ministry, altar guild, acolyting, Rezbearers, Greeters, Ushers, RezCafe, Holy Week volunteer, etc.)
